Attn Wine Club Members: Your Invites To The Fall Tasting Should Be Arriving This Week (10-12-09).

La Quercia Montepulciano d'Abruzzo- "This Montepulciano is a great example of what happens when you match low-yield winemaking expertise with a prolific growing zone, and constantly cut, cut, cut back the vines. Made by winemaker Antonio Lamona, the result is one of the best quality, most expressive and balanced Montepulcianos around. La Quercia, the namesake of the estate, is a type of large, long-lived oak tree that grows on the estate. This wine is also 100% organic, and delivers as a wine that takes no shortcuts. Intense and rich with deep, upfront blackberry fruit. Smooth, well integrated tannin and great, balanced acidity." **\$11.99**



Dark Horse Gunfighter Second Notch Red Blend- "The Syrah gives this wine a rich, smoky backbone while the Zinfandel jumps in with blueberry and red fruit flavors. Cabernet Sauvignon adds another dimension of deep fruit and soft tannins that make the finish long and lasting. Enjoy this wine with whatever you throw on the BBQ." **\$20.99**

Rum Chata- If you buy one cream style liqueur this Fall/Winter, I have to recommend Rum Chata. Rum Chata is a rum based cream liqueur with flavors of cinnamon, vanilla, and ginger. Rum Chata is based on, and tastes similar to, the traditional Hispanic beverage "horchata", which is a sweet, creamy drink made from rice and flavored with cinnamon and vanilla. BEER



Many Oktoberfest beers tend to have malty textures and slightly sweet flavors of caramel and toffee. But what do you do if you're a hop lover? **Southern Tier's Harvest Ale** gives hop lovers a reason to look forward to fall. This isn't nearly as hopped up as a Pale Ale, but the hops create a beer that is a little thicker in consistency than the typical Fall beer. The flavors are still on the sweeter, malty side, but there are some citrusy hop flavors, and the finish does have that hoppy, somewhat bitter backbone that lingers. This is a hybrid beer if I ever saw one, and a good one at that! **\$9.49/6-Pack**

If you're like me, the cold weather makes you crave big, dark beers. One that I have been enjoying lately is the

Porter from Founders Brewing. This beer is huge with maltiness. The nose smells of sweet chocolate which carries over to the flavor and joins tastes of caramel and coffee. The ABV of 6.5% is very well balanced. This is a terrific beer to keep you warm in the coming colder months. **\$9.49/6-Pack**



Want to try something a little different this fall? Look no further than one of the many pumpkin beers out there, specifically **Buffalo Bill's Pumpkin Ale**. Made with pumpkin and spruced up with ginger, nutmeg, and cinnamon, this beer is the next best thing to actual pumpkin pie! **\$7.49/6-Pack**
